Decisions made during January 29, 2020 meeting

- Committee members voted to approve the G. McMichael Request for No-cost Time Extension with Additional Scope (for "Non-Native Predator Recruitment Reduction – Phase 1 project).

IV. Review of Actions Items from December 17, 2019 Meeting (D. Rohr)

- Rohr will distribute Lake Wenatchee / White River questions to Jeff Jorgenson. - Completed
- 3. Murdoch and Rohr will communicate with G. McMichael regarding status of Request for No-Cost Time Extension. **Completed**
- 4. Rohr will follow up with Graf and with Dotson regarding NNI Funding details. **Completed**
- 5. Dotson will distribute copy of NNI Funding guidance Document dated 2013. **Completed**
- V. Review and Activities Update Barkley Irrigation Co. Permanent Point of Diversion Project (D. Rohr) Rohr shared with the PRCC-HabSC at their January 9, 2020 meeting the PRCC December 17th decision to not provide the \$500,000 request for NNI funding for this project. Accordingly, PRCC-HabSC approved the \$500,000 Trout Unlimited request for funding from Habitat Fund 603. PRCC-HabSC is waiting to hear from Trout Unlimited to determine if Ecology has approved funding the additional \$400,000 requested by Trout Unlimited. If Ecology doesn't approve it, PRCC-HabSC has decided they will fund the additional \$400,000. Action: Rohr will keep PRCC advised of the Ecology decision on funding the \$400,000 requested by Trout Unlimited.

VI. Review and Discussion of Lake Wenatchee Activities Regarding White River Spring Chinook Juvenile Migration (D. Rohr)

A. Review of Questions and Answers Sent to Jeff Jorgenson - Murdoch shared some brief comments and discussion regarding Jorgenson's answers to the questions sent to him after the December 17, 2019 PRCC meeting. Additionally, Murdoch commented on the discussion the PRCC Hatchery SC had a couple of weeks ago with Craig Busack/NMFS wherein he addressed questions regarding White River activities. Busack agreed to provide written answers to the questions and Rohr will follow up with Hillman to get a copy for distribution to PRCC members. Graf commented that he will also follow up with Jorgenson and seek the additional information described in Jorgenson's response to carrying capacity for Wenatchee Spring Chinook and information regarding hatchery modeling simulations Jorgenson has run for Greer Maier/UCSRB.

- B. Discussion of Path Forward Rohr has talked with all committee members on the topic of path forward. In talking with Chad Jackson/WDFW, he learned Jackson is putting together a proposal that will be ready for presentation and discussion at the February meeting. Therefore, Rohr suggested detailed discussion of this subject would best be held until the February meeting. All agreed. Murdoch commented that she sees 3 potential options moving forward of (1) do nothing, (2) move forward with an RFP as has been discussed, or (3) develop a defined proposal. Carlon commented as an ACTION item he will do some follow up investigation of information he received from Tom Skiles regarding additional genetic work being done in the Wenatchee Basin by Kristin Nichol/NMFS Science Center, and possibly also by Mike Ford/NMFS Science Center that would relate to the White River discussions.
- VII. (DECISION ITEM) Request for No-cost Time Extension with Additional Scope of Work (for "Non-Native Predator Recruitment Reduction Phase 1) (K. Murdoch, D. Rohr)
 - A. Request for No-Cost Time Extension with Additional Scope of Work "Non-native Predator Recruitment Reduction Phase 1" The co-funding Wasco/McNary Mitigation Fund has approved the extension request to the end of 2020. Between the PRCC NNI Fund & the McNary Mitigation Fund, McMichael is expecting to use only a portion of the remaining funds in the contract. Tom Skiles shared he feels extending this contract takes us further away from NNI funding purposes. Committee members present voted to APPROVE the Request for No-cost Time Extension and additional Scope of Work. Rohr also stated he has received verbal approvals from Jackson, Craig, and Truscott who were absent from today's meeting. ACTION: Murdoch will let Geoff McMichael know of the committee approval and instruct McMichael to work with Dotson on the change order.
 - B. PRCC Review and Comments of 2019 Draft Report "Non-native Predator Recruitment Reduction – Phase 1" – Dotson sent edits/comments to McMichael.
- VIII. CCT 2019 Northern Pike Suppression and Monitoring Project Update to PRCC (K. Truscott) Rohr distributed the report by email to committee members, but Truscott was not available for today's conference call to discuss results.
- IX. 2020 Meeting Logistics (D. Rohr) Rohr stated that he has spoken with all committee members individually about the December 17, 2019 meeting discussion and comments regarding consideration of moving to one day meetings with the HCP CC. Accordingly, today Rohr discussed consideration of holding the PRCC meetings in the afternoon on the same day as the morning HCP CC meetings. After committee discussion, starting in February, the PRCC committee agreed to have meetings on the same day as the HCP

CC on the 4th Tuesday of the month with the option to move meetings between the Wenatchee office, the HOB at Wanapum, and the West Side. At Curt Dotson's request, all agreed to revisit this decision in July to discuss how it is working out for everyone. Curt also shared that holding afternoon meetings can cause the meetings to get rushed and he hoped that would not be the case here. Curt went on to share that if/when meetings are held at Wanapum HOB, which would also include the HCP CC meeting, the HCP CC doesn't have a Grant PUD staff member attending their meetings and, since the meeting is to be held in a secure area, this would need to be cleared through Wanapum Dam Hydro Security. Agreement was reached to hold the next meeting at the Grant PUD Wenatchee office on Tuesday, February 25, 2020, 1-4:00 pm. Rohr commented he also has received verbal approval from those absent from today's meeting. **ACTION**: Rohr will contact John Ferguson, HCP CC chair, to explain the new meeting details and confirm this will work for the HCP CC meetings as well.

X. Review of 2013 PRCC NNI Funding Guidance Document (D. Rohr) Rohr provided a high-level review of this document with the committee. Moreover, as three members were absent from today's meeting, Rohr suggested members spend time reviewing the document and plan for having an in-depth review at a future meeting. All agreed. Graf asked if the PRCC Habitat SC should also review this document and Rohr stated that he would discuss it with them at their next meeting on February 13th. ACTION: Rohr will add this to a future PRCC meeting agenda for review and he will also discuss it with the Habitat SC at their next meeting.

XI. Potpourri (D. Rohr)

A. Review of January UCSRB Science Conference – Committee members that attended the conference stated it was a successful conference that shared a lot of good content.

XII. GENERAL UPDATES

A. Avian Predation Activities (C. Dotson) – Dotson shared activities are in their early stages of prep work for the 2020 season. Dotson also shared Chelan PUD is starting a facility-use fee in 2020. Because RTR is using their smolt station they'll have to pay Chelan a fee. RTR was not aware of this expense when they presented their 2020 NNI-funding request to the PRCC in November, so there may be a request to the PRCC/NNI from RTR for additional funding to cover this expense. Two meetings ago, at the November meeting Truscott brought up the idea of co-funding with BOR to place woody debris on the Island. Dotson presented this idea to the BOR and the BOR was not in favor. They were not overly receptive to the idea, but Dotson felt the door is not closed. Dotson shared Lisa Stark of the BOR Boise office is retiring in March. BOR does have \$150,000 for avian predation management in their 2020 budget. Dotson got the impression that the BOR regional office in Boise feels this work is completed and no longer needs funding. Dotson will be monitoring them to ensure that they use their \$150,000 budget this year. Murdoch asked if BOR shared their concerns of the woody debris idea, and Dotson stated

they did not, and they said their two days a week monitoring plan would be adequate.
